### I. Rationale:

The Fundamentals of IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup> workshops exists to provide attendees with an understanding of the International Standard for Business Aircraft Handling (IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup>) and how to implement this standard to increase safety and efficiency in operations.

#### **II. Course Aims and Outcomes:**

## Aims

This workshop will provide attendees with a deeper understanding of the IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup> and safety management systems (SMS). The information provided in this workshop will enable attendees to confidently start the IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup> implementation process and/or prepare for a registration audit. For those that have already implemented the IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup>, this workshop will reinforce current understanding of the IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup> and SMS while provide information on key changes to the standard.

### Specific Learning Outcomes:

By the end of this course, students will:

Understand who the International Business Aviation Council (IBAC) is and its role with the IS-BAH™:

Understand the rationale for the IS-BAH™ and how implementing this standard improves safety and efficiency in operations;

Understand how performance-based standards provide operator latitude in implementing the IS-BAH™;

Become familiar with the organizational accident and how the IS-BAH™ creates a foundation for sound operating practices;

Understand the evolution of safety thinking to the safety management system and how a formal system of safety management works towards the goal of reducing risk;

Comprehend why the SMS is the cornerstone of the IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup> and works as a foundation to the standards and recommended practices;

Be able to identify key standards in the IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup> across Chapters 4 - 15;

Understand the IS-BAH™ implementation and registration process.





#### III. Format:

The Fundamentals of IS-BAH™ workshop is divided into four modules. Lunch is provided as well as refreshment breaks. Times are estimates and depend on participation and discussion within each module.

Module 2 - Safety Management System (3 hrs.)

Become familiar with the ICAO SMS requirements, including definition and structure

Understand the evolution to the "Organizational Accident" and the need for SMS in an organization.

Understand Error Management and Safety Culture

Become familiar with IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup> Chapter 3 (SMS) requirements.

Module 3 - Standards and Recommended Practices Chapters 4 - 15 (2 hrs.)

Become familiar with the terms policy, process and procedure and the difference between them.

Understand how to develop policy, process, or procedure as required by the IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup>

Become familiar with the IS-BAH<sup>TM</sup> across the following themes:

- Organization
- Scope of Operations

Facilitate understanding of implementing the IS-BAH  $^{\scriptscriptstyle TM}$ 

Facilitate understanding of the IS-BAH™ Audit Process
